SRTC ASN Program Outcomes (POs) and Success Measures

Program Outcome 1: 60% of all students who begin in the RNSG 1931 nursing course in the Generic and LPN-RN Bridge options will complete the program on-time (Generic option within four (4) semesters and LPN-RN Bridge option within three (3) semesters).

The ASN Program will also collect additional program completion data for 150% completion time frame and the ultimate completion rates for Generic option (225%; within three years) and LPN-RN Bridge option (200%; within two years).

Program completion calculates the number of students from the first nursing course (RNSG 1931) through completion of the courses required for the conferral of an Associate of Science in Nursing Degree. (Data based on Academic Year July 1 to June 30 and complete three-year data for program options and campus locations.)

For ACEN Criterion 5.2: The ACEN requires you to submit a substantive change report for your program's annual program completion rate if the following conditions are applicable: Condition 1 Program's overall (all locations, program options, etc.) annual completion rate falls 25% or more below program's established expected level of achievement (ELA) for two (2) consecutive years **OR** Condition 2 Program's overall (all locations, program options, etc.) annual completion rate falls 40% or more below program's established ELA for a single year.



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Program Outcome 2: NCLEX-RN pass rate will be at or above 80% for all first-time test takers during the same 12-month period. Aggregated data for initial licensure pass rates are tracked by calendar year (January to December) and include three years of data, including program options and campus locations.

Georgia Board of Nursing Rule 410-8-.09 states: A passing percentage of at least eighty (80) percent of all first-time writers on the licensing examination over the four (4) most recent years must be maintained.

ACEN Criterion 5.3 states: The program's most recent annual pass rate **OR** the mean pass rate for three most recent years must meet at least one of the following based on the total number of test-takers:

- 80% or greater for all first-time test-takers; or
- 80% or greater for all first-time test-takers and repeaters (Ultimate Pass Rate) *; or
- at or above the national/territorial mean based on the nursing program type.



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Program Outcome 3: Annually, at least 90% of graduates will report job placement in-field as a registered nurse within 6-12 months of graduation. (Data based on Academic Year July 1 to June 30 and data for graduates is reported one academic year behind current AY).
