#### SRTC ASN Program Outcomes (POs) and Success Measures

**Program Outcome 1:** NCLEX-RN pass rate will be at or above 80% for all first-time test takers during the same 12 month period based on an academic year (January to December).

| Year                  | % passing on 1 <sup>st</sup> attempt | National Average |

**Program Outcome 2:** The ASN Program adopted not less than 60% over a 3-year average for the program completer's rate. Program completion is the number of students who are accepted into the nursing program and fulfill the College and Programmatic requirements. (Data based on Academic Year July 1 to June 30 and complete three-year data for campuses.)
